The Build America Transportation Investment Center (BATIC) Institute: An AASHTO Center for Excellence enhances taxpayer value from transportation investment by enhancing public sector capacity in project finance. This occurs through a variety of avenues, including trainings, sharing of best practices, and technical assistance to all State Departments of Transportation (DOTs) and their local partner agencies.

The goals of the BATIC Institute are to increase the capacity of policymakers and project sponsors to: understand project finance tools available to all types of projects; create a sound environment for partnership among project stakeholders; assess projects for delivery via public-private partnerships (P3s) and, if suitable, empower the delivery of projects under this approach.

The BATIC Institute exists as a cooperative agreement between AASHTO and the U.S. Department of Transportation.

Practitioners from across the country have participated in over 20 robust and diverse in-person and online capacity building events, with more events scheduled for the coming year.

IN-PERSON AND ONLINE EVENTS

These in-person peer exchanges, roundtables, and trainings allow for in-depth and spontaneous knowledge sharing and interactive discussions amongst small groups.



The 18 in-person events have resulted in:

- 46 States Represented (plus DC and Puerto Rico)

The BATIC Institute's online events allow for capacity building with a broader outreach, and have facilitated the delivery of comprehensive and wide-ranging information and highlighted resources available for practitioners.

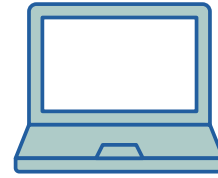

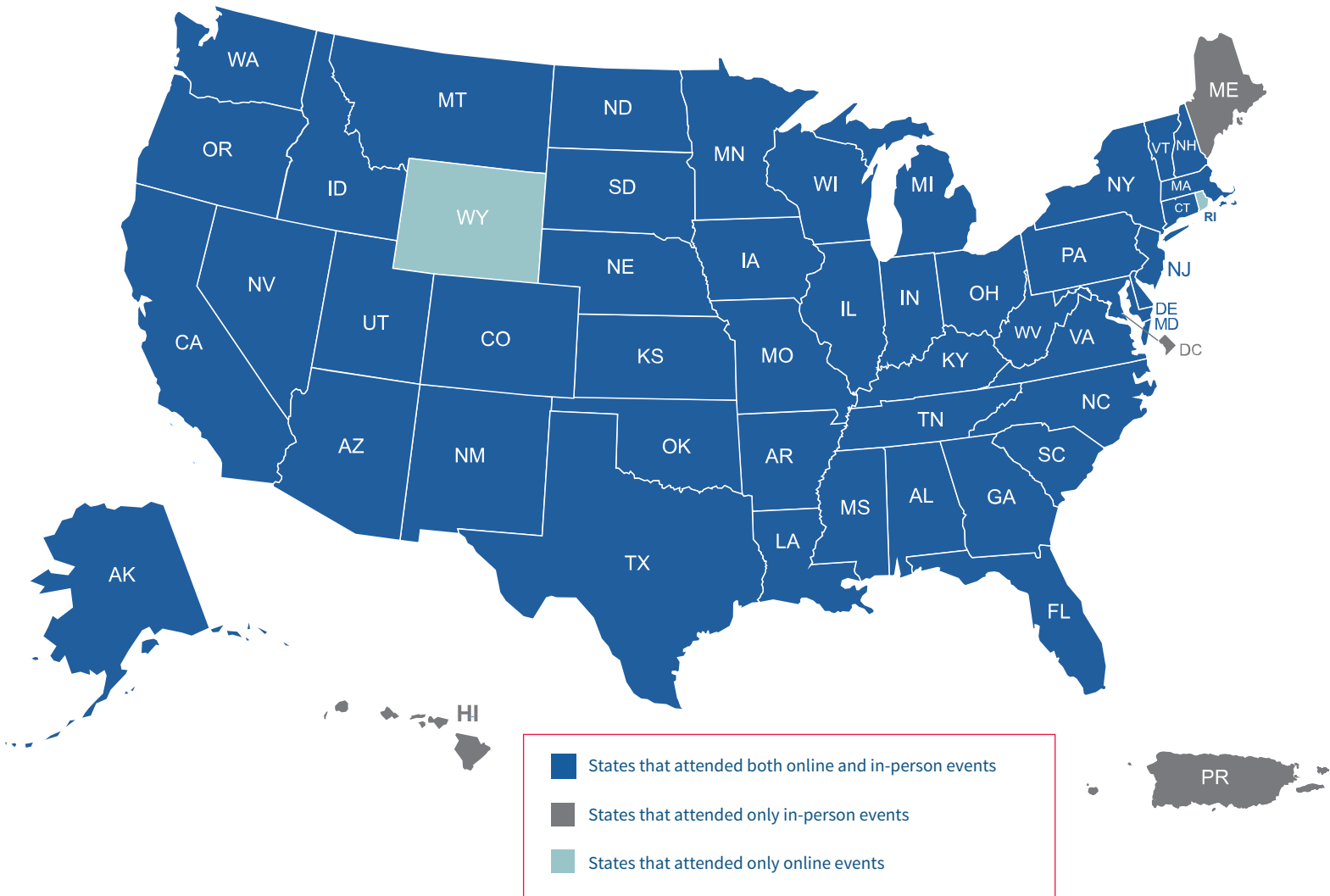


ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSIONS & EXPERT PANEL SESSIONS
